

**Advisory – Note for Celebration of Bhandara of Param Guru Huzur Sahabji Maharaj-  
February-2022.**

**Bhandara of Param Guru Huzur Sahabji Maharaj** will be Celebrated in various Branches in India and Abroad on **Sunday 06<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 during afternoon session at Fields ( with Video Transmission).** Bhandara week will be celebrated in Dayalbagh from **06.02.2022 to 10.02.2022.**

1. Satsangis would, as a precautionary measure, celebrate **February, 2022 Bhandara** in their respective Branches/ Satsang Centres / Area Satsangs /Private Group Satsangs / Individually and **would not travel to Dayalbagh** for the same **except as provided** subsequently in this Advisory Note and subject to any binding directions of the Central/State/Local Government Authorities. **Audio/Video transmission** (as per extant guidelines) would be available to them through the e-Satsang Cascade.
2. All Satsangis of the permitted zones, below the age of 70 years, who are fit and without symptoms of cough, cold and fever can come to Dayalbagh on the occasion of Bhandara on 06<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 for seva. However, those with cough, cold, and fever will have to be certified medically fit at the Branch level locally through Centre In-charge / Branch Secretary/ Regional Secretary or Regional President.

For this purpose, the assessment of the medical fitness of such Satsangis must be carried out by a doctor with minimum MBBS qualification (with details like Registration Number) through any one of the above authorised functionaries.

A list of all asymptomatic Branch members and those assessed medically and found fit should be forwarded by the authorities mentioned above to Dr. S.K. Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital (email- [sah.dayalbagh@gmail.com](mailto:sah.dayalbagh@gmail.com)).

Dr. S.K. Satsangi, Medical Officer In-charge, Saran Ashram Hospital will assess the report and certify the fitness of individual Satsangis and revert with this information to the originator. Satsangis concerned should travel to Dayalbagh ONLY on receiving the certification from Dayalbagh. A copy of this should also be presented at the Registration Centre at the time of getting the TVC made.

Before and during travel and even afterwards, they must observe all precautions - such as, wearing mask, helmet and observing hand-hygiene and social distancing norms. They should bring Branch Identity Card or Identification letter from the Branch Secretary.

3. Permitted Satsangis for **February, 2022 Bhandara** shall include those from a) U.P.Radhasoami Satsang Association (excluding Roorkee, Agra, Lucknow, Varanasi, and Allahabad District Satsang Associations) b) Residents of Dayalbagh, Sabha Members, Sewaks, Part-time Sewaks, Employees of Sabha, Societies- their spouses and children with their spouses and their dependent children c) Members of Holy Families d) Regional Presidents with their spouses and Regional Secretaries only are permitted to attend Bhandara at Dayalbagh.
4. **Additionally, such eligible Initiated Satsangis, from non-permitted Zone, who have come to celebrate Basant-2022, may stay up to 10.02.2022 and attend the Bhandara. They will not be eligible to offer Bhent on this occasion.**
5. Exhibition of Dayalbagh manufactures **would not be held** at Dayalbagh on this occasion.
6. Dayalbagh residents/others would **not** be distributed meals from Dayal Bhandar on the occasion of Bhandara except those who regularly take meals from Dayal Bhandar and any Satsangi/Jigyasus or their families who have arrived for Bhandara at Dayalbagh. DB residents (who are non-regular diners of Dayal Bhandar and all others are advised to cook Bhandara meal at their respective homes.
7. **Offering of Bhent by Initiated Satsangis of permitted zones is scheduled on Monday 07<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.** Bhent limits applicable will be as follows:
  - i. Initiated Satsangis registered in Satsang Branches in India can offer Bhent with a minimum of Rs.10/- and maximum of Rs.2,000/-
  - ii. Initiated Satsangis registered in Satsang Branches Abroad (permitted zone) who happen to be in Dayalbagh, may offer Bhent with a minimum of Rs.100/- and maximum of Rs. 5000/-.
  - iii. Satsangis who have been permitted to visit Dayalbagh of permitted zones would be allowed to offer Bhent as per schedule. They must **wear masks, observe hand hygiene and social distancing norms. Use of helmets is mandatory.**
  - iv. However, other Satsangis of permitted zones who are not coming to Dayalbagh would be allowed to offer Bhent online through NEFT/RTGS to the designated Branch account operated by the Branch Secretary plus two other Satsangis. Those who are unable to transfer the amount electronically can offer cash to Branch Secretary. The Branch Secretary would check each of such receipts to ensure that the amount of Bhent collected at the Branch is as per the Guidelines. It would be remitted in a single transaction by NEFT/RTGS to Sabha and a summarized list as per Form A would be submitted to facilitate reconciliation by Sabha. The particulars of Sabha's account have already been communicated to the Regional Presidents who may be contacted for the purpose **(Schedule and process will be informed separately).**

- Initiation of Jigyasus of the permitted zones who come for Agriculture activities and who fulfill the criteria of para 3 and are desirous of Initiation, would be considered during February, 2022 Bhandara. Jigyasus desirous of receiving Updesh can be permitted to stay longer with due approval of the Secretary, Sabha.
  - For II Updesh (Bhajan-Initiation/Revision) – Please note that this will be given through Video-Conferencing mode and transmitted from Dayalbagh. The Branch Secretaries may ensure that all applications with related papers reach Initiation Section, Dayalbagh-atleast one month prior to the date of Bhandara.
  - Four days field work attendance is mandatory for Updesh (Sumiran & Dhyan)/(Bhajan) applicants.
9. Sale of Pothis and Chyavanprash shall be arranged as per Norms for such permitted Satsangis/Jigyasus.
10. Doctors/paramedic staff/others in Saran Ashram Hospital should take proper care and protection against COVID-19 (Corona Virus) and Hospital premises should be regularly sanitized. Dr.S.K.Satsangi, MOI Saran Ashram Hospital should strictly enforce the instructions for preventive and other requirements pertaining to COVID-19 as have been circulated to Regions.
